## 2024 International Conference of Sport History and Culture in Conjunction with the 9<sup>th</sup> International Conference of Sport for Development and Peace

Theme: Olympic Movement in Asia

The International Conference of Sport History and Culture was initiated in 2015 by the *Asian Journal of Sport History & Culture* and Jiangxi Normal University, China, and Bangor University, UK and becomes an annual event since then. The second took place at Shanghai University of Sport in 2016, the third at Anhui Normal University, Wuhu in 2017; the fourth at Shaanxi Normal University, Xi'an in 2018. The fifth at Zhejiang Normal University, Jinhua in 2019. The sixth took place in Fujian Normal University, Fuzhou in 2021. And the seventh in Universitas Pendidikan Indonesia (UPI), Bandung in 2022. The eighth took place in Yongin University, South Korea in 2023.

The Ninth will take place in **5-7 November 2024** in collaboration with 9<sup>th</sup> International Conference of Sport for Development and Peace 2024 in School of Postgraduate Studies, Universitas Pendidikan Indonesia, Bandung, Indonesia.

The conference will be jointly organised by Universitas Pendidikan Indonesia (UPI), Indonesia; the Asian-Pacific Association of Sport Studies (APASS); Asian Journal of Sport History & Culture (AJSHC, Routledge).

The theme of the conference is the Olympic Movement and the Olympic Games in Asia. It will examine the history and evolution of the Olympic Movement and the Olympic Games in the global context; discuss the core concepts and the government and governance of the Olympic Movement and the Games in the context of Asia; analyse the relationship between the Olympics and politics, nationalism,

economy, education and cultures with special reference to Asia; and critically review the Olympics and the challenges the Olympic Movement and the Games are facing in the future.

**The following research topics and research areas will be welcomed at the conference:**

- The Olympics and the Asia Century;
- The History of the Asian Games;
- The History of the Far Eastern Championship Games, from 1913;
- The History of the Asian Games from 1950 to 2023;
- Research on the GANEFO (the Games of the New Emerging Forces) in Indonesia in 1963;
- The History of the Olympic Movement and the Olympic Games in Asia;
- The government and governance of the Olympic Games in Asian countries:
- Case Study: Olympic Games in Asia: such as: 1962 Tokyo Summer Olympics; 1988 Seoul Summer Olympics; 2008 Beijing Summer Olympics; 2020 Tokyo Summer Olympics; 2022 Beijing Winter Games; the Paralympics;
- The Olympic Council of Asia;
- The Olympic heroes and heroines and sports personalities in Asia;
- The comparative study of the Olympics between the West and East;
- The relationship between the Olympics and politics, diplomacy, nationalism, gender, race, ethnicity, youth, economy, education and culture in Asia;
- The developments and challenges of the Olympic Movement and the Olympics in Asia.
- Sport for development and peace in Asia
- And other related topics and areas.

There are two types of presentation forms that participants can choose: **oral presentation** and **poster presentation**.

For Oral Presentation, participants are requested to submit their abstract in English (no more than 300 English characters with space). The abstract should include the name of the author (s); the authors affiliated universities or institutes, the title of the paper and the text and 5 key words in the system.

For Poster Presentation, participants are requested to submit their poster about their research with poster size Length= 160 cm; Width= 60 cm in PDF. The committee will print the poster and present it at the conference hall. Posters are made to be as attractive as possible and contain important elements in the research.

The conference aims to provide a platform for stimulating and lively interdisciplinary discussions on sports in Asia. It is intended that selected presentations/abstracts will be identified for development and publication in the AJSHC.
